One of the bigger, richer versions of this cuvee, the 2014 Nostre Pais Costières de Nîmes (35% Grenache, 25% Carignan, 20% Syrah and the rest Mourvèdre and Cinsault) was fermented with one-third whole clusters and aged in equal parts 500-liter barrels and concrete tanks. Its deep ruby/purple color is followed by terrific notes of blackberries, blackcurrants, roasted herbs and licorice. It has serious mid-palate depth, integrated acidity and present, yet ripe tannin, all suggesting it will evolve gracefully for at least 4-6 years. *-JD*

The inky purple-colored 2014 Nostre Pais Costieres de Nimes (35% Grenache, 25% Carignan, 20% Syrah and 20% Mourvèdre) comes from rolled pebble and sand terroirs, and was aged in equal parts barrel and concrete tanks. It has beautiful fruit (wild strawberry, blackberries), medium-bodied depth and richness, and terrific purity. It's a killer value as always and a no-brainer purchase. *-JD*
