

New Cadmium Restrictions as of December 10, 2011

On 20 May 2011, the European Commission adopted Regulation (EU) 494/2011 and its amendment, whereby the scope of limitation of cadmium to Annex XVII of the REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 has been extended. This regulation will become effective as of December 10, 2011. Thereafter, products which don't meet the following requirements will no longer be marketable.



The new law expands the scope of the restriction on cadmium (Cd) including jewellery and recycled polyvinyl chloride (PVC). Electrical and electronic products are covered by RoHS directive 2011/65/EU.
