HOW IT WORKS:

Choose a Quiz Master and form teams of up to 4 people. You can also play with one-person teams if that is easier for you to manage, digitally speaking. Each team chooses a team name and a team leader. The leader fills in the answer sheet.

We like to conduct these quizzes via Zoom conferencing, but any video conferencing application will work. Advanced users can set up one primary Zoom for their Quiz Master to run the quiz, and separate team Zooms for conferring about the answers. A chat group can also work for conferring.

Work the quiz in rounds. The Quiz Master asks each question and allows team leaders time to write down their answer. At the end of each round, the quiz master reads out the answers. Each team scores their own round, appointing 5 points to each correct answer, and that round's scores are submitted to the Quiz Master.

The Quiz Master keeps track of each round's points on the master score sheet, and keeps the teams apprised of team standings after each round. At the end of round 4, a winner is announced!

WHAT IF DISPUTES ARISE?

If there is a dispute about an answer it is ultimately up to the Quiz Master to decide if an answer is acceptable or not.

WHAT IS MY PRIZE FOR WINNING?

If fame, glory and recognition among your friends is not enough, why not arrange your own prizes among your quiz group? It could be a skein of yarn donated by someone in the group, it could be a poem written by the quizmaster especially for the winner, it could be anything!

A1: Shawl + blanket (a shawl so large it doubles as a blanket)

Q2: Which baby pattern has the most projects on Ravelry?

A2: Baby Surprise Jacket by Elizabeth Zimmermann

Q3: How many issues of Pom Pom magazine have been published?

A3: 32 (at time of publication!)

Q4: Who invented the first Knitting Machine?

A: William Lee of Nottinghamshire, UK

Q5: When was the knitting machine invented?

A5: 1589 (Stocking Frame Knitting Machine)

ROUND 3: ANATOMY

Q1: What is sheep sweat called?

A1: Suint

Q2: What term is used to describe the length of an animal fiber?

A2: Staple

Q3: What is the technique called when the raw materials are dyed before blending and spinning into yarn?

A3: Dyed in the Wool (also accept Fleece Dyed or Stock Dyed)

Q4: Which direction are a Z-twist and an S-twist yarns twisted?

A4: Z-twist is Clockwise S-twist is counterclockwise (or anticlockwise)

Q5: What are the long, straight, rough fibers called that must be removed from cashmere during processing?

A5: Guard hairs
