COLOUR CHANGE

TEMPORARY

The wood flour in the composite slats contains lignin, sanding exposes the wood fibres to UV light and causes a **yellow-green colour change**. Drip edges and circles are also possible.

The lignin disappears on contact with rain.

After a few weeks, the slats will have returned to their original colour.

You can speed up this process by regularly rinsing with water.

Slats that have already started to discolour can be placed together with slats where this has not yet started.

Pay attention: Slats from **different production series** may show **slight differences in colour**.

OTHER LOOK

PERMANENT

The slats are brushed on 2 different machines, and thus receive a yellow or a white sticker.

The brushes are subject to wear, so the look may be slightly different.

So in 1 panel, always place slats with the same colour sticker in the same place (front/back and top/bottom), to get a nice even look.
