FAQ - SHEEPSKIN

Use

Which features does the Sheepskin offer me?

The Sheepskin is a lovely sheep fur of the sheep breed 'Texelaars'. These sheep are farmer property and the fur is the residue product of the sheep. Using the Sheepskin makes any piece of sitting or lying furniture even more comfortable due to the soft wool working as insulation.

Safety

What safety hazards does the Sheepskin pose?

There are no particular safety hazards.

Maintenance

What do I need to pay attention to when maintaining the Sheepskin?

We advise cleaning the Sheepskin regularly by hand by shaking it out. We strongly advise against washing the Sheepskin. This will lower the dirt-repellent effect of the product. Remove stains with a moist cloth and dry it afterwards with a hairdryer.

How important is maintenance to the Sheepskin?

It's important to treat stains as quickly as possible in order to be able to remove them. Additionally, we recommend regularly shaking it clean so that food residue or other kinds of dirt don't remain.

Which cleaning products can't I use on the Sheepskin?

We advise against using cleaning products on the Sheepskin. A moist cloth will suffice.

Weather conditions

Which weather conditions will the Sheepskin withstand?

The Sheepskin can be used both indoors and outdoors. Please be aware that the Sheepskin usually doesn't withstand rain. When the Sheepskin becomes wet it gets an unpleasant smell. We therefore recommend only using the Sheepskin with dry weather.

Material

What materials does the Sheepskin consist of?

Sheep fur of the breed 'Texelaars'.

How much does the Sheepskin weigh?

The Sheepskin weighs around one kilogram.

Packaging

How will the Sheepskin be packaged?

The Sheepskin will be delivered in a cardboard box.

What packaging materials are used?

Cardboard.

What are the dimensions of the packaging?

20×20×75cm.
