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Introduction

Thank you very much for purchasing your LED TV. It serves as a normal colour TV and a PC monitor. To enjoy your set fully from the very beginning, read this manual carefully and keep it handy for future reference.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Locate the TV in the room where direct light does not strike the screen. Total darkness or a reflection on the picture screen can cause eyestrain. Soft and indirect lighting is recommended for comfortable viewing.
- 2. Allow enough space between the TV and the wall to permit ventilation.
- 3. Avoid excessively warm locations to prevent possible damage to the TV or premature component failure.
- 4. This TV can be connected to AC 100-240V~ 50/60Hz.
- 5. Do not install the TV in a location near heat sources such as radiators, air ducts, direct sunlight, or in closed compartments and closed areas. Do not cover the ventilation openings when using the TV.
- 6. The indicator light will last for about 30 seconds after the power has been tumed off. Wait until the indicator light goes out before repowering the TV.

SAFETY

- 1. DO NOT expose the television to extremely high temperatures (below 5° C and above 35° C) or extreme humidity (less than 10% and more than 75%).
- 2. DO NOT expose the television to direct sunlight.
- 3. Prevent the television from coming into contact with liquids.
- 4. Make sure that no objects get into the television and do not place vases of water on the television.
- 5. Unplug the power cord and remove the antenna cable during a lightning storm (especially during lightning).
- 6. Do not walk on the cable and ensure that the cable is fully unrolled.
- 7. Do not overload outlets or extension cords, as this may result in the risk of fire or electric shock.
- 8. Use a soft, dry cloth (without volatile substances) to clean the television.



Main unit description

Control Panel Button Function

- VOL+ : Volume up.
- VOL-: Volume down
- CH+: TV channel up.
- CH-: TV channel down.

- POWER: Switch on when in standby mode or to enter the standby mode.

TV Connections



Connect the USB to the USB jack on the set

NOTE

- It is only 500 mA MAX of DC current output when you connect with USB jack.
- To ensure the mobile HD works well, you should use other power supply for the mobile HD and don't use the USB jack in the same time.
- It supports mobile HD by connecting with USB jack (must be more than 2 Gb). The partitions of the mobile HD can't be more than 4 partitions. The max partition is 2 Tb. It supports FAT/FAT32 files. The max FAT file is 4Gb and the max FAT32 file is 2Tb.

Swap channels

Press $\blacktriangle \nabla$ to select the channel. Then press select. Move the channel to the positions with $\blacktriangle \nabla$ and press again to confirm.

Press the numeric keys and $\blacktriangle \nabla$ in this menu. You can set channel, date, start time, mode, type and recording length.

Note:

You will need to check first your inserted USB storage device if the recording speed is sufficient and if the format is right. Otherwise, the task will fail. The U disk may be formatted when recorded, please do not store important files in the U disk.

When approaching the preset time, a countdown will appear to remind you of the user menu.

When you open the Edit Timer menu, you can set the recording task you want to record. If you have successfully set the recording task, the TV automatically turns on in standby mode one minute before the task starts. When the recording task starts, it will automatically record.

If the TV enters the wrong standby mode when starting the task, you can press the POWER button to watch the TV program. You can perform the same operation as Direct Record. If you press POWER again, the TV will turn off and continue to record. The TV really turns off until the recording task is completed. If you press the REC.TASK button, you can also enter the timer menu.

Set up

- A. Press ▲▼ to select AUTO ADJUST menu and press or to do auto adjustment.
- B. Press \blacktriangle to select HORIZONTAL POSITION and press the \blacktriangleleft to adjust.
- C. Press $\blacktriangle \forall$ to select VERTICAL POSITION and press the $\blacktriangleleft \triangleright$ to adjust.
- D. Press $\blacktriangle \nabla$ to select CLOCK and press the $\blacktriangleleft \triangleright$ to adjust.
- E. Press ▲▼ to select PHASE and press the ◀▶ to adjust (Only available when inputting PC signal).



Before entering the MEDIA menu, connect the USB device or memory card. Press the 'SOURCE' or 'INPUT' button on the remote control and ▲▼ buttons to select 'MEDIA' source.

Press **MENU** return to the previous menu and press **EXIT** to exit the entire menu.

Press \triangleleft to select the 'PHOTO' option and press \bigcirc to enter.



Press $\blacktriangle \nabla$ to select drive disk you want to watch, and press $\odot \otimes$ to enter. Press the $\blacktriangle \nabla$ and $\odot \otimes$ to select the file you want to watch in the file selecting menu, then press $\blacksquare \blacktriangle$ to play picture.

Press to delete the selected photo and to add all photos to the playlist. To select menu in the bottom you want to run Press \triangleleft and then press \bigcirc to operate.

You can see the information of the current playing picture after pressing the INFO button, then press II \blacktriangle to play or pause. You can see the play status on the right side.

Then \mathbf{AV}/\mathbf{AV} to rotate the image without the control bar.

Press \triangleleft to select the 'MUSIC' option and press \bowtie to enter.



Press $\blacktriangle \nabla$ to select drive disk you want to watch, and press 0 to enter. Press the $\blacktriangle \nabla$ and 0 to select the file you want to listen in the file selecting menu, then press $\blacksquare \blacktriangle$ to play music.

Press \triangleleft to select the menu in the right bottom you want to run and then press **o** to operate.

Press \triangleleft to select the 'MOVIE' option and press **or** to enter.



Press $\blacktriangle \nabla$ to select drive disk you want to watch, and press \odot to enter. Press the $\blacktriangle \nabla$ and \odot to select the file you want to watch in the file selecting menu, then press II \blacktriangle to play movie.

Press \blacktriangleleft to select the menu in the bottom you want to run and then press R to operate.

Press \blacktriangleleft to select the 'E-BOOK' option and press to enter.



Press $\blacktriangle \nabla$ to select drive disk you want to watch, and press to enter. Press the $\blacktriangle \nabla$ and to select the file you want to watch in the file selecting menu, then press to play.

- 1. The file extensions has to be .jpg and not .jpeg.
- 2. Pictures encoding must comply with JPEG/ISO format.
- 3. This DVD player can only display DCF-standard still pictures or JPEG pictures such as TIFF.

NOTE:

Some recorded files may not be played due to the type and format of the disc or condition of the recording.

Carefully read the following instructions before turning on the DVD player for the first time!

Getting started

- 1. Connect the device to a main socket using the power supply unit that is delivered with the device.
- 2. Push the power key on the right side of the TV set.
- 3. Switch to DVD mode and insert a DVD with the label facing backwards. The DVD player automatically starts playing.

Note:

An inserted DVD can only be ejected in the DVD Mode. The eject key has no function in other modes.

Operating the device and general buttons

Depending on the situation, you can use the buttons on the device or on the remote control to operate the device. However, the remote control allows greater use of the device functions.
