Introduction

Thank you very much for purchasing your LED TV. It serves as a normal colour TV and a PC monitor. To enjoy your set fully from the very beginning, read this manual carefully and keep it handy for future reference.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Locate the TV in the room where direct light does not strike the screen. Total darkness or a reflection on the picture screen can cause eyestrain. Soft and indirect lighting is recommended for comfortable viewing.
- 2. Allow enough space between the TV and the wall to permit ventilation.
- 3. Avoid excessively warm locations to prevent possible damage to the TV or premature component failure.
- 4. This TV can be connected to AC 100-240V~ 50/60Hz.
- 5. Do not install the TV in a location near heat sources such as radiators, air ducts, direct sunlight, or in closed compartments and closed areas. Do not cover the ventilation openings when using the TV.
- 6. The indicator light will last for about 30 seconds after the power has been tumed off. Wait until the indicator light goes out before repowering the TV.

SAFETY

- 1. DO NOT expose the television to extremely high temperatures (below 5° C and above 35° C) or extreme humidity (less than 10% and more than 75%).
- 2. DO NOT expose the television to direct sunlight.
- 3. Prevent the television from coming into contact with liquids.
- 4. Make sure that no objects get into the television and do not place vases of water on the television.
- 5. Unplug the power cord and remove the antenna cable during a lightning storm (especially during lightning).
- 6. Do not walk on the cable and ensure that the cable is fully unrolled.
- 7. Do not overload outlets or extension cords, as this may result in the risk of fire or electric shock.
- 8. Use a soft, dry cloth (without volatile substances) to clean the television.



TV Connections

NOTE

- It is only 500 mA MAX of DC current output when you connect with USB jack.
- To ensure the mobile HD works well, you should use other power supply for the mobile HD and don't use the USB jack in the same time.
- It supports mobile HD by connecting with USB jack (must be more than 2 Gb). The partitions of the mobile HD can't be more than 4 partitions. The max partition is 2 Tb. It supports FAT/FAT32 files. The max FAT file is 4Gb and the max FAT32 file is 2Tb.



Modulation

Press ◀▶ to select the Modulation: 16QAM/32QAM/64QAM/128QAM/256QAM.

Press number keys (0-9) to set the symbol rate or automatically search symbol rate.

Completion of the above settings, user can start channel search.





Surround: Press ▲▼ to select Surround, then press to enter and press ◀▶ to select ON or OFF. Then press to return back the previous menu directly.

AVL: Press ▲▼ to select AVL, then press to enter and press ◀▶ to select ON or OFF. Then press to return back the previous menu directly.

Sound menu

Digital Audio Output: Press ▲▼ to select Digital Audio Output, then press to enter and press ◀▶ to select. Available in S/PDIF mode: OFF, PCM, AUTO).

Audio Description

Press or ▶ to enter the menu in the DTV source. You can open the audio description and adjust the Mixing Level.



Press or ▶ to enter and press ◀▶ to adjust. Then press to return back the previous menu directly.







Parental Control: Press ▲▼ to select PARENTAL CONTROL, then press or ► to enter the sub menu. Then press ◀► to select Rate (From 4-17 or None). Press ■ to confirm.

Key Lock: Press ▲▼ to select KEY LOCK, then press to enter and press to select ON or OFF.

Change Password: Press ▲▼ to select CHANGE PASSWORD , then press to enter and Change Password menu will appear as follows:



Enter the new password in 'New password'. Enter the new password again in 'Confirm new password'. If all goes well, 'successfully updated' will appear after a few seconds. If not, there is a difference between the two passwords and you must do it again.

Auto Power Down (turn off the TV automatically)

Press ▲▼ to select AUTO POWER DOWN and press ◀▶ to select Off / 1 hour / 2 hours / 3 hours / 4 hours.



Record Menu: Press ▲▼ to select RECORD MENU, then press to enter the sub menu. The new sub menu will look as follows:



Schedule: Press ◀▶ to select SCHEDULE, then press to enter and the sub menu will appear as follows (you will set the schedule task):



Record: Press ◀▶ to select RECORD, then press to enter record. The function is same as the hot key of REC.

Time Shift: Press ◀▶ to select TIME SHIFT then press to confirm. The function is same as the hot key of Timeshift.

PVR File List: Press ◀▶ to select PVR FILE LIST, then press to enter the sub menu. You will play the record file. Press ▲▼ to select the file and press the to play.



Disk Setup: Press ◀▶ to select DISK SETUP, then press to the sub menu where you can select and/or format the external disk which is connected by USB.



Setup menu

OSD Timer: Press ▲▼ to select OSD TIMER. Press ◀▶ to select how long the OSD Menu has to stay on the TV. (Available OSD Timer: 10 sec., 20 sec., 30 sec., 40 sec., 50 sec., 60 sec. or off). Then press [STER] to confirm.

Blue Screen: Press $\blacktriangle \blacktriangledown$ to select BLUE SCREEN. Press $\blacktriangleleft \blacktriangleright$ to select On or Off. Then press to confirm.

Sleep Timer: Press ▲▼ to select SLEEP TIMER,. Press ◀▶ to select how long the TV has to stay on before it turns off by himself. (Available Sleep Timer: 00:15, 00:30, 01:00, 01:30, 02:00 and OFF). Then press to confirm.

Location: Press $\blacktriangle \blacktriangledown$ to select LOCATION. Press $\blacktriangleleft \blacktriangleright$ to select Home or Store. Then press to confirm.

Quick Setup: Press $\blacktriangle V$ to select QUICK SETUP. Press ever to enter the sub menu. Enter the password if locked and then you can quickly make some basic settings of the TV.

Reset TV: Press $\blacktriangle \blacktriangledown$ to select RESET TV. Press to enter the sub menu. Enter the password if locked and then you can restore factory settings.



Electronic Program Guide (EPG)

Press on the remote to display the EPG programmers list. Then press to show the different EPG info. The menu looks as follows:



Press on the remote control to switch between the TV or Radio channel.

Press on the remote control to select previous day program info.

Press on the remote control to select next day program info.

Press on the remote control to enter the schedule list menu.

Select **FAV** to set the favorites channels.

Select to enter the schedule menu, you can set the record task.

Press CH+/- on the remote control to turn the page.

Direct record

How to Direct Record

In the DTV source, you can start record function by press the "REC" key while program playing. Before that, you have to make sure the USB storage device is inserted and the device checking and initialization is done.

If you press "REC" key when there's no USB storage device inserted, the prompt window will appear as follow:



If you press "REC" key during the device checking and Initialization, the prompt window will show black screen about 2 seconds. When the TV is recording, it will appear the recording menu.



You can press 'STOP' key to stop record function after confirm.





Time shift

How to Time shift

In the DTV source, you can start time shift function by press the **II** key while program playing. Before that, you have to make sure the USB storage device is inserted and the device checking and initialization is done.

If you press **II** key when there's no USB storage device inserted, the prompt window will appear as follow:



If you press >II key during the device checking and initialization, the prompt window will show black screen about 2 seconds. When the TV is time shifting, it will appear the time shift menu.



After timeshift started, you can select the items for the functions: PLAY/PAUSE/STOP/AB/FF/FR/PRVE/NEXT.

You can see the detail info by the timeshift menu.

Time shift

- ▶II PLAY/PAUSE: you can set the play mode PLAY/PAUSE
- STOP: you can stop the recording, it will appear the menu for check whether to stop the recording.

AB: you can set two point for play the record file from A to B.

- ▶▶ FF: you can set the play mode Fast Forward;
- ◄ FR: you can set the play mode Fast Rewind;

PRVE/NEXT: you can play the record file to previous/next for 30 seconds.

After record started, you can press the button of PLAY/FF/FR/PRVE/NEXT on the remote control. You can play the record file by PLAY/PAUSE/FF/FR/PRVE/NEXT/STOP.

You can press \blacksquare to jump to the realtime broadcast of the program, and if you press \blacksquare again, you can stop timeshift function after confirm.



Note:

Timeshift function will stop when there's no space left on the USB storage device.



Media Operation

Note: Before operation MEDIA menu, plug in USB device or memory card, then press SOURCE button to set the Source to Media.



Press $\blacktriangle \blacktriangledown$ to select HDMI/USB in the Source Menu and then press \blacksquare or \blacktriangleright to enter.

Troubleshooting

Before contacting our service department you can go through the following for possible solutions.

Problem	Solution
TV will not turn on	 Make sure the power cord is plugged in. The batteries in the remote control may be drained; replace the batteries.
No picture, no sound	 Check the cable between TV and antenna/external AV device. Press the power button on the remote. Press the SOURCE button the remote, then press the ▼▲ button repeatedly to select the TV source.
Poor picture, sound OK	 Check the cable between TV and antenna/ external AV device. Try another channel, the station may have broadcast difficulties. Adjust the brightness/contrast in the Video menu. Check that the unit is set to PAL
Audio noise	 Check if the cables are connected properly. Move any infrared equipment away from the TV.
No audio	Make sure the volume is not turned off or set to minimum.
Photos, videos and music from a USB device are not displayed	 Check if the USB storage device is capable of mass storage, as described in the documentation that came with the storage device. Check if the USB storage device is compatible with the TV Check if the audio and image file formats are supported by the TV.

Troubleshooting

USB files are played jerkily	The speed of the USB storage device can affect the speed of data transfer to the TV, preventing image and / or sound from being smoothly
	displayed.
