

## RING SIZE GUIDE

This document will help you find your ring size.

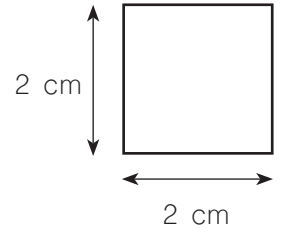
### STEP 1



Print this file in Actual size, if you don't have this option print the size in 100%

### STEP 2

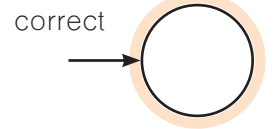
To dubbel check if the size guide is printed 100%, measure the box on the right, it should be **exactly** 2 x 2 cm.









### MEASUREMNT RING

1. Select a ring of your own that properly fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring.
3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.

### MEASURING YOUR FINGER

Your ring should fit your finger comfortably; tight enough so that it will not fall out, but loose enough to slide over your knuckle. Finger size changes depending on the time of day and the weather. For best results measure your finger size:

1. At the end of the day and when your fingers are warm (Fingers are smaller in the early morning and when cold.)
2. Measure your finger size 3 to 4 times to eliminate an incorrect reading. Avoid using string or paper to measure ring size as these materials can stretch or twist, wich results to an inaccurate measurement.
