**APPLICATION AND USE** 

**Preparation** Rinse with fresh or salt water to remove loose dirt.

**Method** Choose appropriate mixing ratio. Add the required number of capfuls of Boat Shampoo to fresh or salt water. Wash

surface with a cloth or sponge. Wash surface section-by-section starting at the highest point first, until all dirt is

removed. Dry the surface with a clean cloth for best results.

Hints Mixing Shake well before use.

**Some Important Points** Product temperature should be minimum 5°C/41°F and maximum 35°C/95°F.
