# STOOL COVERS - HAAKPRET

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## You will need:

#### **STOOL COVER**

#### **Basis: Canada(Lammy) - Hook size 4,5** Cover in Yellow-Brown Flecked:

- 3x 50 g in Creme 016 Cover in Grey Flecked:
- 3x 50 g Grey Tweed 420

#### *Fur: Rabbit (100 g) - Hook size 4,5*

Cover in Yellow-Brown Flecked:

- 2x 100g 18 Cover in Grey Flecked:
- 2x 100g 15

### Techniques

All abbreviations and basic techniques can be found online. Downloads: www.haakpret.nl under 'Haakpret Helps'.

Work the base for the stool using Canada in the same size as the stool. Always insert the hook in the back loop (blp) for the base. The base will be covered up later on, so the colour doesn't matter.

Work the fur later in the front loops (flp) using Rabbit to give the stool cover its fluffy appearance.

Start the base using Canada. Work a circle until the diameter is 1 cm smaller than the diameter of the stool seat. Then continue working without increasing, see p. 4.

#### Base stool cover with fur

#### Always insert hook in the back loop

- 8 dc in magic ring, position the CC, continue working spiral rounds
- 2 8x (1 dc inc) /16
- **3** 8x (1 dc inc 1 dc) /24
- **4** 8x (2 dc 1 dc inc) /32
- **5** 1 dc 7x (1 dc inc 3 dc) 1 dc inc 2 dc / 40
- **6** 8x (4 dc 1 dc inc) /48
- 7 2 dc 7x (1 dc inc 5 dc) 1 dc inc -3 dc / 56
- **8** 7x (1 dc inc 7 dc) /63
- **9** 5 dc 6x (1 dc inc 8 dc) 1 dc inc -

- 3 dc / 70
- **/0** 7x (9 dc 1 dc inc) /77
- II 3 dc 6x (1 dc inc 10 dc) 1 dc inc -7 dc / 84
- **12** 8 dc 6x (1 dc inc 11 dc) 1 dc inc - 3 dc / 91
- **/3** 7x (1 dc inc 12 dc) /98
- **14** 4 dc 6x (1 dc inc 13 dc) 1 dc inc - 9 dc / 105
- **/5** 10 dc 6x (1 dc inc 14 dc) 1 dc inc - 4 dc / 112
- **16** 7x (1 dc inc 15 dc) /119

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- 7 5 dc 6x (1 dc inc 16 dc) 1 dc inc - 11 dc / 126
- **/8** 10 dc 6x (1 dc inc 17 dc) 1 dc inc - 7 dc / 133

From here, the diameter of the example is 1 cm smaller than the seat of the stool. Now continue working without increasing / 133 dc.

Tip: The circle for the base does not need to reach the edge of the seat as the cover will get bigger in the following rounds anyway.

If the size of your work varies, adjust it.

If the cover is too small: Continue working and increase by 7 dc in every rnd until the circle is the desired size.

If the cover is too big: Rip a few rnd until the circle is the desired size.

When the diameter is correct, do not work any more increases.

#### **/9 - 35** 133 dc

When the desired height of the side section is reached, work another 3 rnd with decreases: Decrease 7 dc per rnd. Tip: If necessary, correct the number of rnd now.

Stool cover with Canada:

- **36** 7x (dc2tog 17 dc) /126
- **37** 8 dc 6x (dc2tog 16 dc) dc2tog 8 dc / 119
- **38** 7x (dc2tog 15 dc) /112, fasten off.



Thread a double length of yarn (Catona) at the dc of the last rnd in Canada. Pull thread tightly and tie off. Do not tie too tightly as otherwise you will not be able to remove the cover for washing.



## Crocheting the fur

Using Rabbit, work the fur in the front loops (flp) using the same hook as with Canada: Work 1 sl st with Rabbit at every 3rd flp and work 1 ch in between.

Crochet quite loosely, as if the cover ends up being too tight it won't fit.

If necessary, work 2 ch between the sl st instead of 1.

Attention: If you work too loosely, you may need more yarn and 1 ball of Rabbit will not be enough.

Stretch the work every so often and place it around the seat of the stool. If the cover is too tight, work more loosely.

Start at the first loop of rnd 1. Work as follows in the flp up to the 3rd from last rnd: 1 ch - 1 sl st at 3rd flp from hook.

The Rabbit yarn by Rellana (100 g / 65 m),) is very soft, which makes it ideal for the stool! This yarn is available in various colours via Haakpret: https://www.haakpret.nl/en/yarns/rellana/rabbit/





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
