MX Helmets

« Take a tape measure and measure the circumference of your head 2.5 cm above the eyebrows (at the base of your forehead). Then refer to the attached table.

The helmet should always shake your cheeks at the beginning, the linings always end up getting tight »

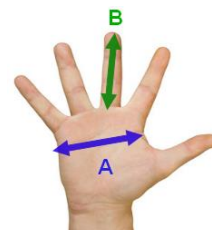

Gloves

- B- The length of your middle finger



Take the average of both results : $(A+B)/2$. Then refer to the attached table. If you found an intermediate size, choose the bigger size »

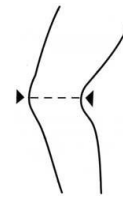

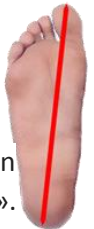
