

Wall sticker installation instructions

Note: Good adhesion is obtained on almost all clean, dry, smooth hard surfaces (for example: smooth walls, aluminum, chrome, stainless steel, glass, plastic). The stickers do not adhere well to drywall/primer finish, textured paint, stucco, metallic paint or washable latex. Thoroughly clean the wall before applying the sticker (you can remove grease with f.e. benzine or spirits, but be careful not to damage any paint layer). If the wall has just been painted, wait for at least 2-3 weeks (this is a guideline), make sure that the wall is really dry.

In case of doubt

Ask us to send you a sample, and test whether this test sticker adheres well to a discrete spot on your wall. Leave the sticker for at least 4 days and see if it also adheres well to the edges.

About the decal



The sticker consists of three layers: 1. The backing paper (back sheet) 2. The sticker itself 3. The semi-transparent transfer tape. Due to the rolling up for packaging, the sticker can look wrinkled. This is unavoidable and has no effect on the final result. You can stick the sticker with an (old) plastic credit card or similar (to brush away the air under the sticker).

1. Prepare

Take the sticker out of the package and leave it with the convex side up, until the sticker is flat again. Place the sticker on a smooth surface with the transparant paper up. And rub the plastic card firmly over the transfer tape (this way the sticker adheres to the transfer tape). At a corner you can remove the transfer tape a little to see if the sticker stays on it. If that is not the case, continue rubbing the card until this is the case. With some stickers you first have to cut the various parts loose, for example trees with animals, the animals are separate from the tree, so that you can stick them where you like best.



2. Choose the right positions on the wall

For large stickers, you use masking tape for the right position. We recommend sticking the large stickers with 2 people. Make sure the sticker is straight and at the correct height. Make sure the correct position is only the image of the sticker not the paper around it. Stick the sticker with masking tape on the wall, or one of the 2 people can hold it well at the right height.



3. Sticking

Do this preferably with 2 people. The back sheet is then carefully pulled loose from top to bottom, slightly off the surface. The card is rubbed over the transfer tape from left to right or from top to bottom in order to stick the sticker properly on the wall. It is important to do this carefully and firmly so that no air remains behind the sticker. Make sure that the sticker does not come off with the application foil. If that does happen, go back a little and rub the card over this part again, until the entire sticker is on the wall.



4. Removing the transfer tape

The transfer tape can be removed after +/- 10 minutes. The sticker is then clearly visible. Gently peel the transfer tape from top to bottom, keeping as close to the wall as possible. This is to prevent you from pulling the sticker off the wall with the transfer tape. If the sticker does not stick on the wall, go back a bit, brush the card again over the transfer tape. Then continue until the sticker is fully seated on the wall.
