



# THE COVERS SPECIALIST

Manual for:  
**Longlife boat  
covers**



The cover can be used to cover the boat during trailer transport or when mooring at the quay and storage on shore.

The cover is mainly intended to keep the boat clean from dust, leaves, bird droppings, discolouration and rain.

- **1.** Fully open the cover. Note the label 'front' which indicates the front.
- **2.** If possible, remove the various protruding accessories from the boat (tholes etc.) and cover any sharp edges with a cloth.
- **3.** If the boat has a ring or eye on the front and rear, rig part of the supplied rope from the front to the rear of the boat to prevent the cover from any sagging due to water. (**see 1.1**)
- **4.** With larger spans, it is possible to place a support pole (option) in the boat.
- **5.** Hold down the labelled side and first place the V-shape over the point of the boat, then pull the sail backwards over the rear of the boat.
- **6.** The zoomed drawstring will hold the cover in place.

For extra security in strong winds, the supplied straps can be rigged around the boat.

**We strongly advise against using the protective covers over other covering materials or fabrics and/or sunroofs.**

For additional firmness and with trailer transport you can use the supplied straps to fix the cover.



### **Storage**

If the cover is not being used, make sure it is dry before placing it back in the bag.

### **Maintenance**

Do not spray the cover with a pressure washer, the cover and the coat layer will be damaged, thereby losing effect.

Take a non-scratching sponge with lukewarm water and dab the cover with it.

In the event of heavy or prolonged rainfall, use your discretion to check the cover for water skins to prevent wear areas and to ensure functionality.

### **Warranty**

The guarantee expires if the above is not adhered to. With normal use, a 1-year warranty applies.
