Approx Age	Your baby's stage	Carrying Positions
0 - 4 months	May want to be carried a LOT! Does not have full head control so needs snug support for the length of their back and neck. Take extra care with safe positioning to protect their breathing	Front Carry (Parent facing)
4 - 6+ months	Has full head and neck control ; can hold their own head up steady and unsupported as you move about. Enjoys looking around but may get easily tired or overstimulated.	Front Carry (Parent facing) Front Facing Carry Hip Carry
6 - 12+ months	Can sit up unaided and is getting much more active! May like to have their arms free and enjoy seeing your face as they get more social.	Front Carry (Parent facing) Front Facing Carry* Hip Carry Back Carry

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Please read this instruction manual carefully before you use your Izmi® Baby Carrier.

This carrier is ideal to use from newborn and is suitable for use with babies between 3.2kg/7lbs and 15kg/33lbs. Ideal for use from newborn to 12 months+. From around 12 months you may find the Izmi® Adventure Carrier more supportive for your growing child. You can extend the width and height to ensure an ergonomic fit as your baby grows.

Your Izmi® Baby Carrier is designed to be easy to put on by yourself. First read all instructions, warnings and safety information. To get confident using your carrier safely you can practice with a soft toy or doll, while sitting on a bed or sofa, or in front of a mirror. WARNINGS! To Ensure Your Baby's Safety:

- Always follow the guidelines for safe carrying.
- For pre-term, low birthweight babies and children with medical needs, seek advice from a health professional before using this product. These children are at greater risk of suffocation.
- The guideline age ranges in this manual may not be realistic if your baby was born prematurely.
- Adjust all straps correctly to ensure your child is held high on your chest and close to your body to support their back and prevent slumping. If the straps are too loose then your child is at greater risk of falling and their breathing being restricted.
- Regularly inspect your carrier for any signs of wear and damage. Stop using the carrier if any parts are missing or damaged.
- Use one Izmi® Baby Carrier to carry one child only. Keep this carrier away from children when it is not in use.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD:

- When using the carrier constantly monitor your child, and ensure that nose and mouth are unobstructed. Their face should be visible, uncovered and not pressed against your body.
- Ensure your child's chin is not resting on their chest as breathing may be restricted, which could lead to suffocation.
- Babies under 4 months can suffocate if held in a slumped position, if the carrier is too low or too loose. Ensure the carrier is tight enough to support their body in an upright position high against your chest.

FALL HAZARD:

- To prevent hazards from falling ensure that your child is securely positioned in the carrier at all times.
- Your balance may be adversely affected by your movement and that of your child. Take care when bending or leaning forwards or sideways.
- Be aware there is an increased risk of your child falling out of the carrier as they become more active.
- Be aware of hazards around you; avoid heat sources, hot drinks and unsafe environments.
- This carrier is not suitable for use during sporting activities, while driving or instead of a car seat.
