



1. Place the cutout colour side up (logo face down). Start with the 4 folds on the outer edge and fold them up .



2. Turn over the cutout and now fold across all the solid lines. We will get to the dotted lines later.



3. Assemble a long sides by forming a "wall" from the folds you have created. The first fold from step one will be facing up on the colour side when the wall is formed.



4. Move to the corner and push in along the dotted line



5. Lift up the adjoining side piece to fold in along the dotted line



6.. Bring the outside flap over the fold with the dotted line.



7. Use a finger to tuck in the fold under the flap.



8. Push down firmly to lock the corner into place.



9. Move to the next corner and repeat from step 5. You may need to push in the folds along the dotted line along the last two corners together to help you shape the last edge.



10. Take the next flat cutout and repeat the process from step 1. This will give you the top and bottom pieces.



11. Take the main body of the box and open it up to fold it into shape.

12. Place the body into one of the other pieces to act as the bottom of the box.

13. Simply put the other piece you have folded on to the top and there you have it, your own Olbaa cake box.



Tips to help!

The cutout has a lot of lines on it. The solid lines are fold lines. You will need to fold every solid line to help shape your box.

The process is the same for both top and bottom pieces. They are interchangeable.
