

 Place the cutout glossy side up. Start with the 2 folds on the outer edge and fold them up.



5. Assemble the short sides by using the "teeth" of the flaps to lock together.



9. Push the tabs into the holes provided to lock in the shape. Repeat from step 5 to do the other side. CAUTION: take your time with this step so not to tear the edges



13. Here's how it looks with the compartments. You're almost done!



2. Turn over the cutout and now fold across all the solid lines. We will get to the dotted lines later.



6.. Push the teeth down so they are flat



10. You will now have formed the base box. Do a little dance!



14. Take the outer box and shape it into the outside box and slide over the inner box.



3. Assemble the long sides by forming a "wall" from the folds you have created. The first fold from step one will be facing up on the glossy side when the wall is formed.



7. While holding the teeth down, push along the dotted fold lines to "pinch" the sides



11. Take the long thin cutout and fold across each fold line and shape the cutout so that the glossy side is up and you've created compartments for the macarons.



15. Now you have your completed cakesicle box. Time to put some fabulous cakesicles on display!




4. Repeat the same process on the other side.



8. While still pinching along the dotted fold lines, fold in the side and bring the flap over the teeth.



12. Place the cutout inside the box and make sure the tabs are all inserted into the holes in the box.



The cutout has a lot of lines on it. The solid lines are fold lines. You will need to fold every solid line to help shape your box.

Place a palette knife edge on the fold lines to help when you fold.
