
# User Manual: COVERT T-Series 4, 6, 8, 10 Lighthead Traffic Advisor


#### Warning!!!

## **Installation**

#### Warning!!!

If you need to drill holes for mounting this product, please be careful not to damage any vehicle components/parts during the process. Please check both sides of the mounting surface before drilling. After drilling, make sure you de-burr any holes and remove any remnants. Grommets are also required to be installed in all wire passage holes. Then, use a sealant as recommended by your vehicle manufacturer to seal any holes so as to make them air and watertight

#### Power Cable

- -Route lightbar power cables close to the vehicles power supply (battery)
- -Install suggested fuse to the end of the **Thick Red** wire of the power cable then connect to the power supply (battery)
- -Connect the **Thick Black** wire to the vehicle chassis ground right next to the power supply (battery)

#### **Function Cable**

- -Route Function cables to a suitable control box (User Supplied; Maximum of 20A for Power wire, 2.5A for function wire)
- -Connect the required wires to the control box base according to the control box' installation guide
- -Apply the appropriate function wire to Power cable (Red Thick) to activate function
- -Apply the Blue wire to the Power cable (Red Thick) momentarily to change flash pattern



# Secure the Lightbar



- 1. Place the side angel adjustable bracket to your desired position.
- 2. Should you choose to secure the lightbar onto the roof of the vehicle, follow the drill hole on the bracket and drill a 2mm wide hole into the roof of the vehicle.
- 3. Using a suitable bolt to secure the bracket onto the roof of the vehicle via the drill hole.
