About this guide

At ABCspecialist, we supply complex automotive components for Audi, Bentley, Mercedes-Benz, and Porsche. Our parts come in different conditions — each with its own quality level, price point, and intended use.

This guide helps you understand exactly what you are ordering, so you can choose the right part to order with confidence.

1. Used Original Part

Genuine OEM part · Previously installed · Tested for function · Most economical

What does this mean for you?

A used part is a **genuine OEM component removed from a donor vehicle**. It has been previously installed and operated in a real application. The part is supplied as removed — meaning it carries the full wear history of its previous service life. Used parts are not restored, rebuilt, or renewed in any way.

At ABCspecialist, used parts are inspected and tested for basic operational function before listing. They are not a restoration category — they are a supply category. You are purchasing a genuine, working OEM component at the lowest possible price point.

How it works

- 1 Genuine OEM part sourced from a donor vehicle or dismantler.
- 2 Part is visually inspected for damage, corrosion, and physical condition.
- 3 Where applicable, basic functional testing is performed.
- 4 Part is cleaned, photographed, and described accurately.
- 5 Supplied as-is — no disassembly, no renewal, no component replacement.

ABCspecialist Quality Standard

Every used part listed by ABCspecialist has been visually assessed and, where possible, tested. We describe condition honestly — including any visible wear, marks, or age-related characteristics. We do not list parts with known damage or known structural defects.

Warranty

Used Original Parts are supplied as-is and do not carry a warranty.

What to expect after installation

A used part will restore your vehicle to working condition using a genuine OEM component. Performance will reflect the wear state of the specific unit — which will have accumulated mileage and operational hours in its previous application. 2. Refurbished Original Part

A refurbished part is a genuine OEM component that has been **partially disassembled — only to the extent needed** — to identify and repair a specific, clearly failed component. It is the most minimal intervention category. The goal is to restore basic operation, not to address general wear or extend long-term service life.

How it works

- 1 The unit is disassembled only as far as necessary to reach the failed component.
- 2 The specific failed part is identified and replaced.
- 3 No full teardown, comprehensive cleaning, or systematic inspection of all internal components takes place.
- 4 General wear and tear, debris accumulation, and broader internal condition are not addressed.
- 5 The unit is cleaned, reassembled, and functionally tested to confirm basic operation.

ABCspecialist Quality Standard

Refurbished parts at ABCspecialist are clearly identified as such. We supply refurbished units where a confirmed single-fault repair has been carried out and the unit has been tested for basic operational function. We are transparent that refurbished parts do not carry the internal renewal of rebuilt or remanufactured units — customers should have realistic expectations about the category's limitations.

Warranty

ABCspecialist does not apply a fixed standard warranty period to this category.

What to expect after installation

A refurbished part will resolve the specific fault that caused the failure and restore the unit to working operation. It will not address other wear that may be present internally. The service life following a refurbish is not significantly extended beyond fixing the immediate issue — other internal wear remains as it was.

3. Reconditioned Original Part

A reconditioned part is a **genuine OEM component that has been partially to fully disassembled, cleaned, and individually assessed**. Worn or failed components found during inspection are replaced;

those confirmed within serviceable tolerance are retained. It sits as the practical middle ground between refurbishing (minimal intervention) and remanufacturing (complete renewal).

How it works

- 1 The unit is disassembled to a depth appropriate to the component type and condition.
- 2 All accessible components are cleaned and individually inspected.
- 3 Components found to be worn beyond acceptable limits or failed are replaced.
- 4 Components confirmed within serviceable tolerance are retained.
- 5 The unit is reassembled and tested to confirm reliable operational function.

ABCspecialist Quality Standard

Reconditioned parts at ABCspecialist are assessed by experienced technicians familiar with the specific requirements of premium vehicle systems. Unlike refurbishing — which targets a single fault — reconditioning involves a broader internal review. The depth of intervention is proportionate to what the unit actually requires, making it a cost-effective choice for units with moderate wear that do not need a full remanufacturing process.

4. Rebuilt Original Part

When you order a rebuilt part from ABCspecialist, you are receiving a **genuine OEM component** — the original housing, casting, or block from the vehicle manufacturer — that has been completely disassembled, meticulously cleaned, and thoroughly inspected by skilled technicians to confirm the full performance.

How it works

- 1 The unit is fully disassembled and every component individually inspected.
- 2 Components that fail inspection or fall outside the manufacturer's acceptable wear limits are replaced with new parts that meet or exceed original specifications.
- 3 Components that remain within acceptable wear limits are retained — deliberately — to reduce both cost and environmental waste.
- 4 The unit is reassembled and tested to confirm full functional performance before dispatch.

- 2 Every single wear-susceptible component — seals, gaskets, pistons, valves, bearings, and all internal parts — is replaced without exception.
- 3 The only element retained from the original unit is the core or block itself, and only if it is confirmed to be in rebuildable condition.
- 4 All replacement parts are sourced to OEM-equivalent specifications. At ABCspecialist, we make every effort to source original or OEM-grade replacement components to preserve full system integrity.
- 5 The reassembled unit is tested against a defined protocol equivalent to new production standards before dispatch.

6. New OEM Aftermarket Part

- 5 Sold new — no prior installation, no wear history.

7. Brand New OEM Part

However, it was **produced and stored some time ago**. It is original OEM production, not a copy or substitute, but it has been in storage rather than in active supply.

NOS parts are particularly valuable for older and discontinued models where genuine OEM production has ended. They offer original manufacturer quality at the point of manufacture — with the understanding that storage and age may have left minor cosmetic traces.
