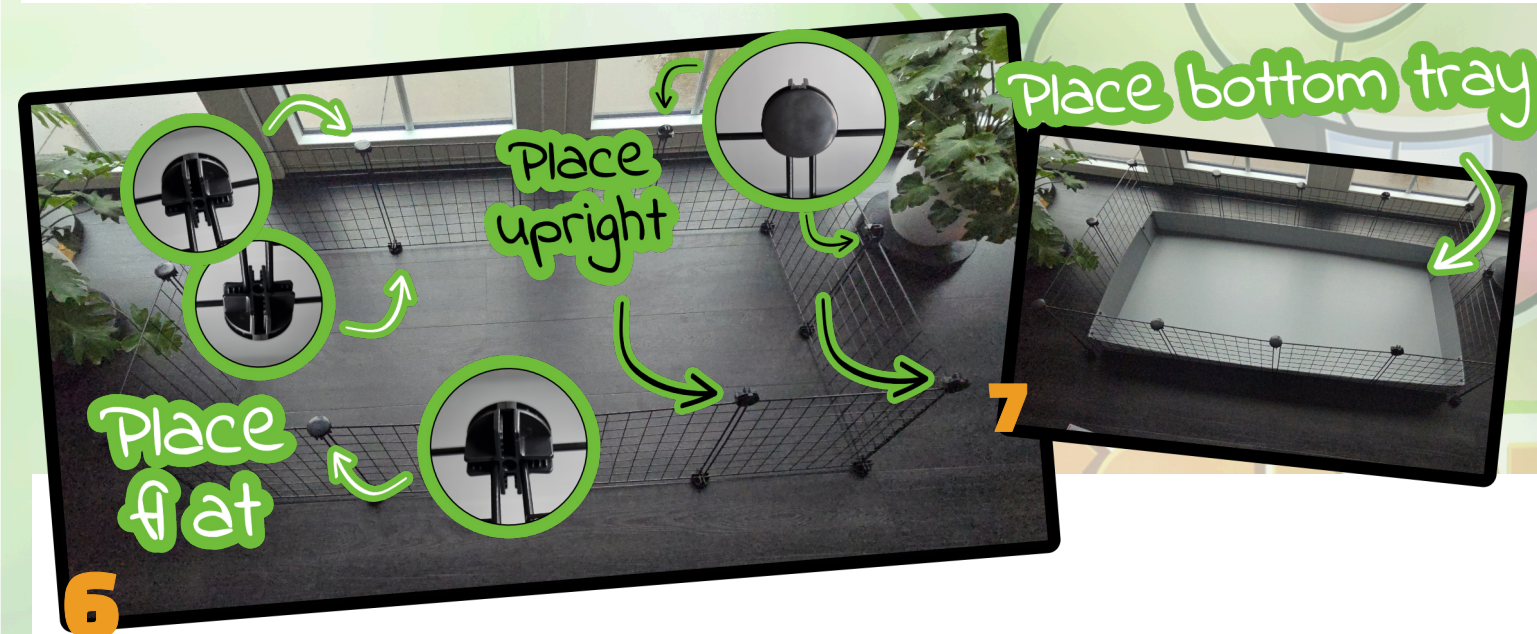


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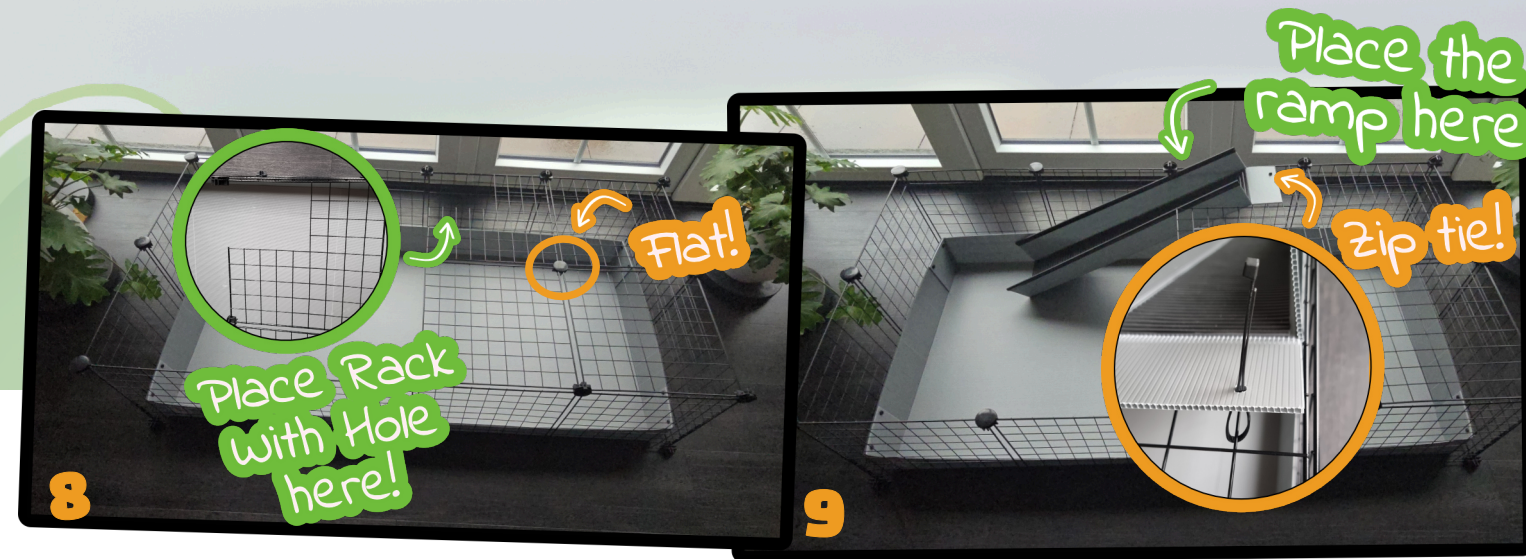


1. The box as the cage arrives **2.** Inner packaging with all parts **3.** The base plate + loft plate **4.** The base plate **5.** Fold the sides of the base plate upwards, with the small flaps facing inward



6. Place the grids upright using the connectors. The layout depends on the size of the cage. In the example, we have a 4x2 cage, which means 4 grids in length and 2 grids in width. The connectors should be placed flat, except where the loft will be placed on top—there, the connectors should be positioned upright. If you have a cage without a loft, all connectors should be placed flat. **7.** Place the bottom tray between the grids.

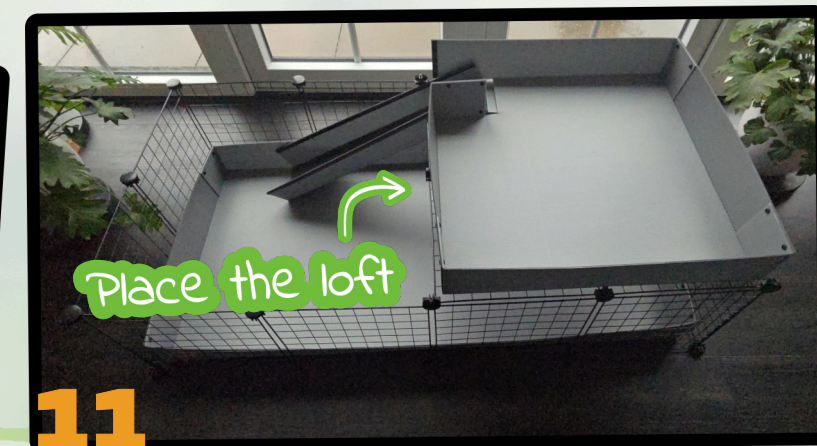
Important! Press the grids firmly into the connectors; otherwise, you will have too much space left. Make sure everything is tightly pressed together.



8. Place the grids where the loft will be flat and position the grid with the hole in the top left corner, as shown in the image. Place the middle connector flat, as indicated in orange in the image. **9.** Place the ramp in the hole of the grid. Secure the ramp with the included zip tie.

LOFT

10. Fold the loft together, just like the base plate. The small flaps should face inward.



11. Place the loft on top of the flat-lying grids.



12. Place the grids upright around the loft and connect them with the connectors.

Tip! It is possible to add a roof to the loft by attaching extra grids flat on top of it. Additional grids and connectors are required for this, which are available separately.
