

# Game instructions

## GB Words for Laying GB

### Down, de luxe

Art.-No. 3414

Contents : 1 wooden box , 1 folding game board with 7 x 14 boxes and 49 printed dices  
(with letters, numbers and symbols).

#### **Preparation:**

Firstly, you take all the dices from the box, you shuffle them and divide in the middle of the table. Each player then takes the same amount of dices and puts them in front. Should there be extra dices, they will be put at the side as reserves.  
You will then unfold the game board (with 98 boxes) and put it in the middle of the table. (The game board may also be enlarged by placing other copies of it.)

#### **Rules of the game:**

1. You will be playing clockwise.
2. Firstly, you shall decide whether you will place words or arithmetic tasks. The youngest player should start first, by putting one of his dices on the selected box. Important is that a letter or number is visible on the dice surface. You cannot start the game by placing a symbol.
3. The players can place one of their dices on a preferred box, but only if there is another dice next to it.
4. Words, sentences and arithmetic equations can be placed horizontally, vertically or diagonally as long as the result makes sense.
5. Question marks can be used as placeholders for a letter or number, or used as a joker.
6. If a player can't place any of his dices on the table, he will be skipping the turn, or pick up one of the extra dices (if any) put apart at the beginning of the game.

**The game ends** as soon as one of the players manages to place all of his dices, or if no player can place some.

The player that successfully placed all of his dices, or owns the least of them, **wins** the game.
