

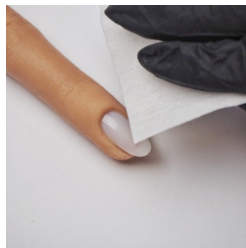

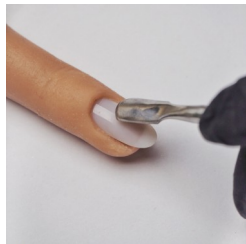


## Basic Application for Lecenté™ Create Rainbow Gel Polish

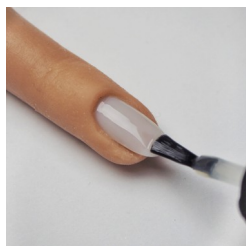
1. Cleanse the nail using  
IPA.



2. Perform dry manicure  
and lightly buff out any  
imperfections if  
necessary.



3. Apply a thin layer of  
**Lecenté Create Base  
Coat** and cure in the  
**Lecenté lamp** for 30  
seconds.



4. Apply **Lecenté Create  
Colour Coat Gel**, loading  
the brush with a good  
amount of product and  
cure in the lamp for 30  
seconds. Choose *Black  
Magic* to intensify the  
final finish or *White  
Magic* for a brighter  
finish.



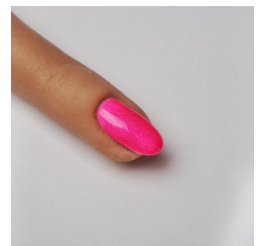
5. Apply a layer of  
**Lecenté Create Rainbow  
Gel Polish** and cure in the  
lamp for 60 seconds. For a  
more intense sparkle, you  
can apply a second coat.



6. Apply a layer of **Le-  
centé Create Top Coat**,  
ensuring that the free  
edge is capped and cure  
for 30 seconds.



7. **Removal:** Please turn  
over for details.



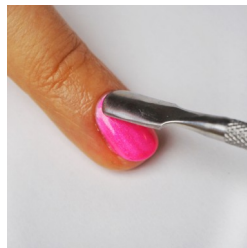

A step-by-step guide for removal of  
Lecenté™ Create Gel Polish.



1. Prepare to remove by pushing the cuticle back.



2. Break the free edge and sides using a 240 grit file.



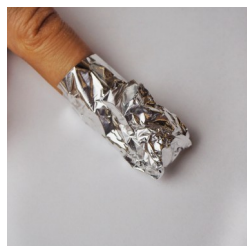
3. Gently but firmly buff over the nail with your file to remove the top coat.



4. Saturate your **Lecenté Removal Wrap** cotton pad well with acetone.

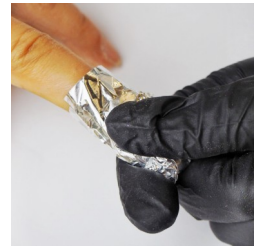


5. Wrap the nail with the removal wrap, rubbing the soaked pad into the nail before folding the foil over and **on top** of the nail.

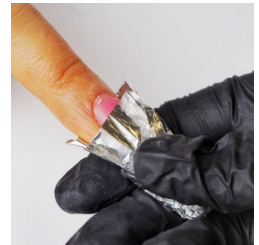


**\*Make sure the foil is folded back on top of the nail plate & the pad is in good contact with the nail plate—this retains heat & makes for an easier removal.\***

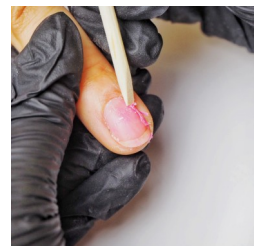
6. Leave for 20 minutes (from the first nail you wrap). Every 5 minutes give each nail a squeeze.



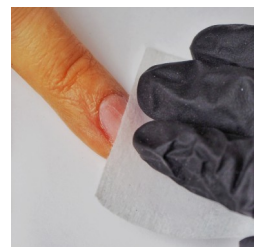
7. Starting from the nail you began with, working one nail at a time, begin removing by twisting & pulling your nail wraps off.



8. Remove any excess with a birchwood stick.



9. When finished use a clean lint free wipe with some acetone and wipe over the nail.

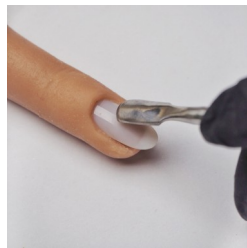

## P.E.P. & Lecenté™ Create Base Coat



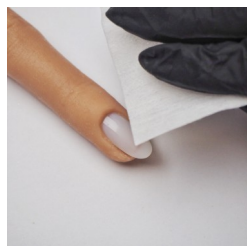
### P.E.P. Guidelines

1. Cleanse the nail using IPA and perform a dry manicure. Ensure the cuticles are pushed back with the **Lecenté Cuticle Tool** and remove any non-living tissue from the nail plate.



2. File and shape the nail. Seal the free edge with a 240 grit file at a 45 degree downwards angle to stop separation and peeling. Make sure the file is swiped under the free edge.

**3. If your client has perfect nails you can move onto step 4. If your client has damaged nails we recommend gently removing any imperfections with a buffer to ensure a smooth surface.**

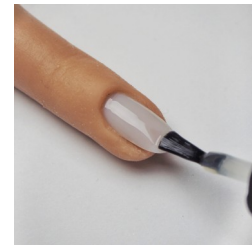


4. Cleanse again with IPA and replace your desk towel.

### Base Coat Application

1. Shake **Lecenté Base Coat** well.

2. To apply the base coat, ensure you have a small amount of product on your brush. We advise that you wipe off one side of your brush. Starting from a third of the way down the nail splaying the brush out, work the product towards the cuticle, sweeping down the nail to the free edge. Repeat on each side of the nail holding the skin at the side of the nails to get full coverage.



3. Thoroughly cap the free edge, making sure you pull back the skin under the free edge of short nails. If you get any product on the skin, wipe away with your cuticle tool or a birchwood stick.

4. Cure in the **Lecenté Lamp** for 30 seconds.

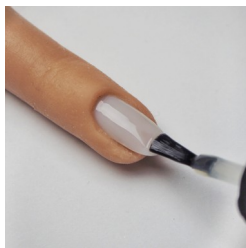

## Lecenté™ Create Colour Coat & Top Coat Application

### Colour Coat Application

1. Perform P.E.P. and apply **Lecenté Create Base Coat** following our step-by-step guidelines.



2. Shake **Lecenté Create Colour Coat** well.

3. Starting on the little finger, have a liberal amount of product on the brush and start a third of the way down the nail, working towards the cuticle, pulling back and sweeping down the nail to the free edge. Repeat until nail is covered. Use a light touch, gliding the product over the nail to ensure full and even colour coverage. Make sure to cap the free edge and sides.



4. Cure in the **Lecenté Lamp** for 30 seconds.

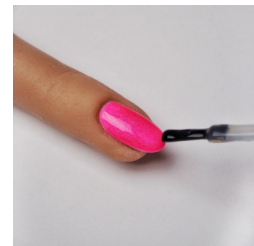
**Lecenté Create Colour Coats are highly pigmented & when applied correctly should only require one coat, however if you wish to apply a second coat you may.**

5. Apply **Lecenté Create Top Coat**—please refer to our top coat step-by-step guidelines.

### Top Coat Application

1. Ensure you have a liberal amount of top coat on your brush.

2. Starting from a third of the way down the nail, splay the brush out and work the product towards the cuticle, before sweeping back to the free edge.



3. Hold the skin at the sides of the nail to ensure full coverage.

4. Cap the free edge and sides, making sure you pull back the skin under the free edge of short nails. If you get any product on the skin wipe away with your **Lecenté Cuticle Tool** or birchwood stick.

5. Cure for 30 seconds in the **Lecenté Lamp**. Please note this is a non-wipe top coat.

## Lecenté™ Create Rainbow Gel Polish Application



### Application over Lecenté Colour Coat

1. Perform P.E.P. & apply base coat and colour coat as per our step-by-step guidelines. Do not apply top coat.



2. Shake **Lecenté Rainbow Gel Polish** well.

3. Apply a layer of rainbow gel polish by starting a third of the way down the nail, working the product towards the cuticle, pulling back and sweeping to the free edge. Cap the free edge and sides.



4. Cure in the **Lecenté Lamp** for 60 seconds.

5. If you want a more intense, pigmented finish, apply a second coat and cure for 60 seconds.

### Application over Lecenté Base Coat

1. Perform P.E.P. & apply base coat as per our step-by-step guidelines.

2. Shake your **Lecenté Rainbow Gel Polish**.

3. Apply a layer of gel polish by starting a third of the way down the nail, working the product towards the cuticle, pulling back and sweeping to the free edge. Cap the free edge and sides.

4. Cure in the **Lecenté Lamp** for 60 seconds.

5. For added intensity, apply a second coat of Lecenté Rainbow Gel Polish, using the same technique and cure for 60 seconds.



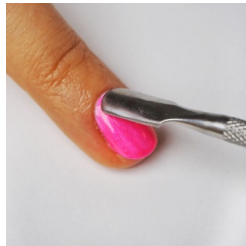

A step-by-step guide for removal of Lecenté™ Create Gel Polish.

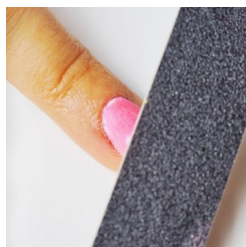
1. Prepare to remove by pushing the cuticle back.



2. Break the colour on the free edge and the sides using a 240 grit file gently but firmly.



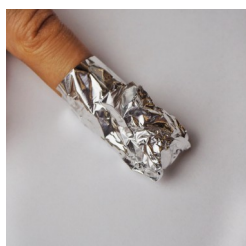
3. Gently but firmly buff over the nail with your file to remove the top coat.



4. Saturate your **Lecenté Removal Wrap** cotton pad well with acetone.

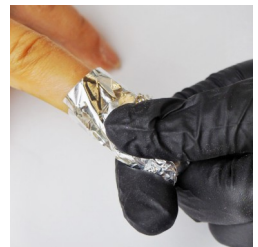


5. Wrap the nail with the removal wrap, rubbing the soaked pad into the nail before folding the foil over and on top of the nail.



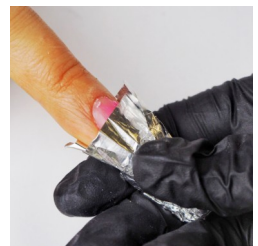
**\*Make sure the foil is folded back on top of the nail plate & the pad is in good contact with the nail plate—this retains heat & makes for an easier removal.\***

6. Set a timer for 20 minutes & time from when you wrapped the first nail.

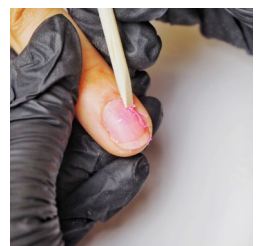


7. Every 5 minutes give the nail bed a squeeze to reinforce the acetone onto the nail. While you are waiting, file your birchwood stick to make it sharper.

8. After 20 minutes start removal, beginning with the first nail you wrapped. Twist and pull the nail wraps off.



9. Remove any excess with a birchwood stick.



10. When finished use a clean lint free wipe with some acetone and wipe over the nail.
